- People Power is the only way - Register your details by clicking on 'Reach Out' on the AAG website. Entering your information helps with creating a database of like minded people that could be called upon to assist others in your area should the need arise.

- Become a financial member of AAG - Membership assists in campaign funding and on assessment may be entitled to :
  - Advocacy Assistance on specific campaigns.

- Object to all NFAEP notices in your letter box - These notices are not addressed to you by name and many ignore them, throwing them in the bin. By ignoring them you are tacitly agreeing to the toxic chemical treatment. Reach out for details on how to do this.

# Campaigns

**FINANCIAL MEMBERS** – As a paid member, you can vote on current AAG campaigns. The majority decision wins. A non-response counts as a 'Yes' vote; to opt out, submit a 'No' vote. Voting remains open for seven days. You may nominate new campaigns for future voting rounds.
