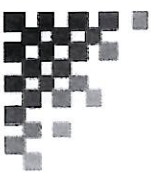

That on the 16th day of April 2025 at Adare in the Magistrates Courts District of Ipswich in the State of Queensland one Trevor Andrew Hold obstructed a Police Officer namely Trudi Helen Flintham in the performance of the officers duties

**The facts in relation to this matter are as follows:**

**Facts of the charge 1 of 1**

The defendant in this matter is Trevor Andrew HOLD who is a 46 year old man who resides at 477 Gatton Esk Road, Adare. At about 8am on the 16th of April 2025 officers from the National Fireant Eradication Team (NFET) attended at the Gatton Police station in relation to their planned attendance at the defendant's residence. The request for police assistance was as a result of online threats and ideologies held by the defendant relating to the fireant program. NFET staff advised there had been substantial communication with the defendant prior to their attendance.

At about 8:43am on the 16th of April 2025 police attended at the residence and spoke to the defendant and a large number of supporters present at the address. The defendant and others present were advised the team would be entering the property to treat in accordance with the Biosecurity Act and that any person who obstructed the authorised officers would be committing an offence. They were further warned that any member of the group who obstructed police could be arrested and a copy of the relevant legislation was referenced and then handed to one of the supporters. Police then left the property at the request of the defendant and subsequently re-entered in company with the Fireant team.

At about 8:47am police and NFET staff entered the driveway of the defendant's residence where authorised officer Roger MORRIS spoke to him and provided the necessary authorisations and identification to lawfully enter the property under the Biosecurity Act. At about 9:02am MORRIS read the official warning relating to the obstruction of officers entering under Section 261 of the Biosecurity Act and the relevant offence section. The defendant spoke over the officer throughout, voicing his grievances with the program.

Following the issuing of the warning, NFET staff entered the property at which time the defendant attended the second gate onto the property and closed it utilising a hook latch and bracing his foot and hand against the gate. Police and NFET workers remained at the gate and Police spoke to the defendant and explained that he was committing an offence by preventing the NFET staff entering. He was warned to let go of the gate and allow staff to enter which he refused. He was then warned that he was committing an offence but continued to hold the gate. At about 9:16am Police undid the hook latch and again warned the defendant that he was obstructing police, he continued to brace the gate with his hand and foot and police pulled the gate open to allow entry to the NFET workers. A few minutes later the defendant showed police a small injury to the inside of his palm which he sustained as a result of holding the gate closed and QAS and first aid were offered.

The defendant declined first aid and stated he would wait for the ambulance and then proceeded to follow the NFET staff around the property, further obstructing their lawful efforts to treat his property.

At about 9:28am the defendant was arrested in relation to another offence and was placed into the marked police vehicle and transported onto Gatton Esk Road where police were met by QAS staff. QAS subsequently transorted the defendant to the Gatton Hospital in police custody. At about 10am the arrest of the defendant was discontinued and he was released with a notice to appear in relation to the matter currently before the court.

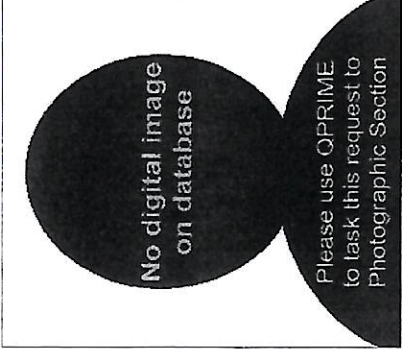
